MoneyGram Haas F1 Team confirmed as MK Job Show Main Sponsor

Established by American industrialist Gene Haas - founder and owner of Haas Automation, MoneyGram Haas F1 Team debuted in 2016, scoring points in its first- ever grand prix, before going on to finish fifth overall in the Constructors' Championship in 2018. Last season the team scored its maiden Formula 1 pole position - with Kevin Magnussen topping the field in qualifying at the Brazilian Grand Prix.

MoneyGram Haas F1 Team is the only American team on the grid, but their workforce is truly global. They have over 200 employees split across three sites in the US, UK, and Italy, working tirelessly on creating a new era of racing for the team.

Their Banbury factory is based in the heart of the UK's Motorsport Valley- where several teams and suppliers are located - all within a short drive to Silverstone circuit, home to the British Grand Prix.

The Banbury site houses many of their operations functions - including Logistics, Electrical Engineering, Vehicle Science, Control Systems, Vehicle Performance and Programme Management, as well as our Race Team Support and Communications Department. They have dedicated support services ensuring constant communication and collaboration between sites, including Accounting, Administration, Human Resources, IT and Purchasing departments.

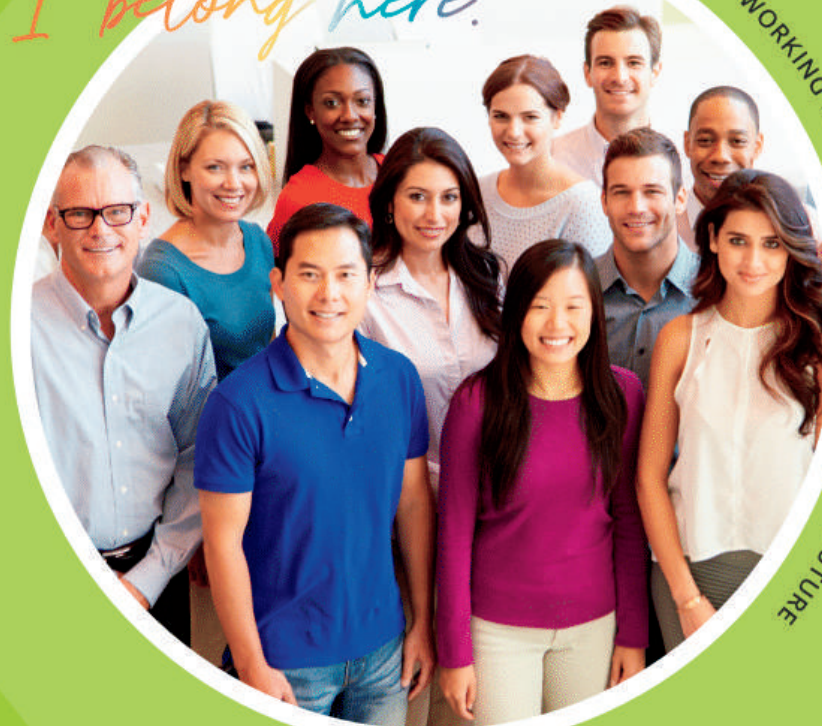

Find your job in 25 conversations



Many people worry about what job they should do. Some write countless job applications and become demoralised by the lack of positive responses. '25 conversations' is a method which provides quick feedback and encourages further action. It takes the job-seeker on a short journey of self-discovery which ends in a job that is enjoyable and pays.

Developed by charity Worktree, the method can be used by anyone. It is for people who are ready to try something different and willing to develop their conversation skills. It involves simply having a series of conversations, reflecting on what you learnt from them, then planning how and with who to have the next conversation. All that's needed is the motivation to start, ability to talk, and commitment to finish.

Here are the 25 conversations:

- Family & Friends (1-5) – What are my strengths?
- Their Friends (6-10) – What jobs use my strengths?
- Employees (11-15) – What's like to do those jobs?
- Employers (16-20) – What do the employers want?
- Interviewers (21-25) – What do the interviewers want?

For some it takes courage to talk, but it's one of the things we were born to do... and should do more often.

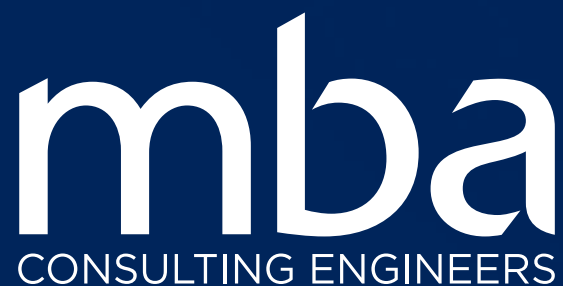

North Bucks Bellringers



English style bellringing is a voluntary activity that gained popularity in the 17th century and is now performed throughout the English speaking world. As you might expect, church bells are mostly found in churches. In this country, the Church of England's churches have most of the bells. Ringers refer to these as "towers" rather than churches, so you can see already that there is a whole different language to be learned as well.

When bells are rung they are swung until they are upside down where they can be held, balanced, until each bell is needed. There is an ingenious mechanism that holds the bell in place. This arrangement allows the ringers to be able to strike their bell at exactly the right moment while requiring very little physical effort.

Ringers get to ring for Sunday services, as you would expect, and also other church events. It is not essential to be a "church person" but it can help at first as you get to learn what is going on. Weddings are popular with youngsters as the ringers get paid. National events provide opportunities for a bit of local recognition. The "Ring for the King" initiative is generating a steady stream of enquiries from ordinary people who always wondered if they could have a go.

There are also ringing opportunities that are organised for social or training purposes. Most towers with bands will hold a regular weekly practice evening. These are usually on weekdays between 7:30 and 9:00. When you become more proficient, there are opportunities to ring in full peals, lasting more than 3 hours, and quarter peals.

Bands in this area are members of the Oxford Diocesan Guild of Church Bell Ringers. This organisation arranges training sessions, practices, competitions, open days and, as you might expect, a few meetings.

Most people can learn to ring but, like any performance art, it can take some time to become an expert. To get you started structured starter sessions have been arranged to follow up this show. Alternatively, we can put you in touch with your local ringers who can look after you.

In the North Bucks area there are 59 towers with bells so it is quite likely that there are bellringers near where you live.

Once you can ring, you will be made welcome very nearly anywhere there are bells. You are not tied to one place so it is not unusual for ringers to ring at several towers in their area.
